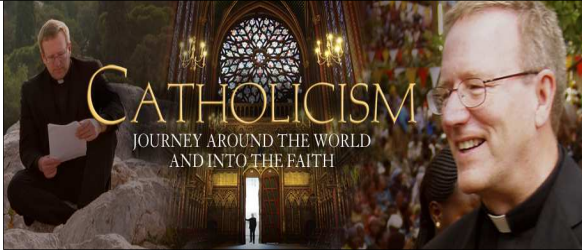
Prayer Before a Test:
