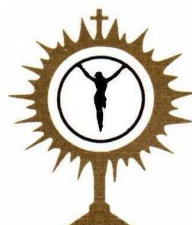

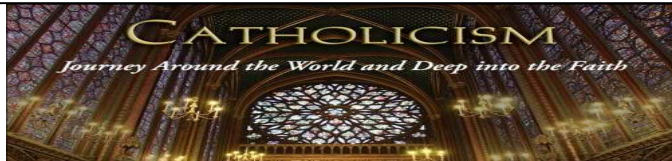
We welcome into our community those recently baptised: Robyn Debra Dillon-Reid, Preston Gerard Shevlin.

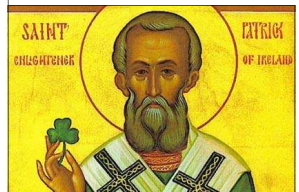

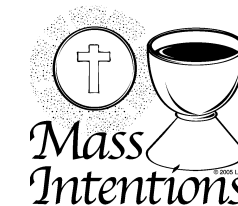
