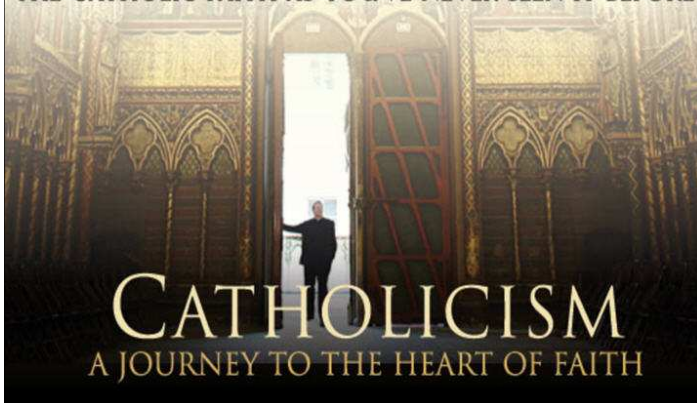
**There is a special collection** today on Vocations Sunday for Diocesan Education.
