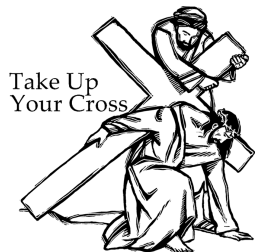

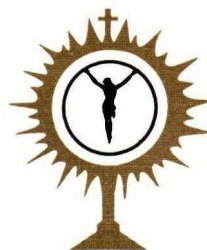
Lenten Stations of the Cross

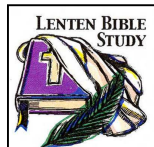
We welcome into our community those recently baptised: Ella Farrell, Amiyah English, Emilie Dullaghan-McNally, Méabh Murphy.
