Charitable Donations - CHY3 Certs: A good number of parishioners have returned their CHY3 certs to the parish office and we thank them for this. The parish is able to claim tax back on these forms and it is a vital source of revenue. Therefore, we would ask parishioners who have not yet returned their forms to try and do so immediately as our accountant is waiting for the completed forms. If you have not received a form and contribute over €250 a year to the Church through the parish envelope, the collection plate or the Parish Dues and would like a CHY3 cert issued, please contact the Parish office. World meeting of families: Pope Francis has chosen Ireland to host the 9th World Meeting of Families during 2018. The dates and theme of the Meeting will be announced by Pope Francis himself. The 9th World Meeting of Families is expected to attract thousands of Catholic families from around the globe to Ireland in 2018. It is hoped that this very special pastoral initiative will present all of us in the Church with the opportunity, and the challenge, to renew, support and strengthen Irish families in their commitment to their faith.

The World Meeting of Families was a pastoral initiative of St John Paul II. Held every three years, and coordinated by the Pontifical Council for the Family, it is the largest universal gathering of Catholic families and brings together families from all over the world in faith and celebration. Hosting a global event of this size requires a huge amount of planning and financial outlay on behalf of the host country. Accordingly, our bishops have now established a National Finance Committee to provide advice on the financial planning for the world Meeting of Families in Ireland. **To support the hosting of the event we intend to hold three national church collections, the first of which will take place on the weekend of 28th-29th May.** The remaining collections will take place in 2017 and 2018. 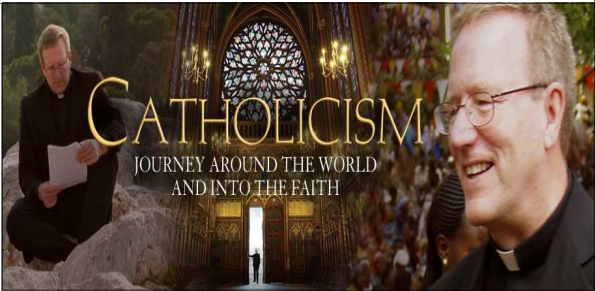

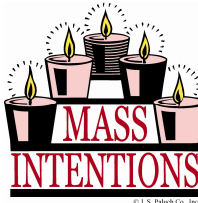
