MARY'S GREAT PROMISE AT FATIMA The five first Saturday's are



intended to honor and to make reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This devotion and the wonderful promises connected with it were revealed by the Blessed Virgin at Fatima, a small village in Portugal. Our lady appeared to three children there in 1917, and one of the little girls, Lucy, tells us that Our Lady said: I promise to help at the hour of death, with the graces needed for salvation, whoever on the First Saturday of five consecutive months shall:

- 1. Confess and Receive Communion.
- 2. Recite five decades of the Rosary (Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful, or Glorious Mysteries)
- 3. Keep me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the fifteen Mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me.

NOTE: The Confession may be made during the 8 days preceding or following the First Saturday as long as the one receiving Communion is in the state of grace. The Rosary may be recited at any convenient time of the day. Our Lady idicates that the 15 minutes meditation on the Rosary mysteries is separate from the prayer of the Rosary. This is also clear from Sr.Lucia's writings.
