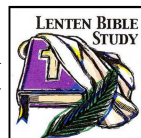
We are encouraging all parishioners to attend, especially during the hours allocated to Holy Redeemer.

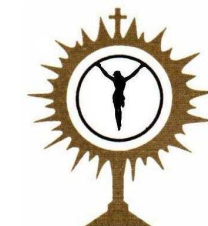
