In this celebration we proclaim our belief in the Real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We also proclaim that same Jesus lives within each one of us who are baptized into His Body, the Church. St. Thomas Aquinas said the Eucharist is the one instance of change we encounter in this world that is exactly the opposite. The appearances of bread and wine stay

the same, but the very essence or substance of these realities, which can't be detected by a microscope, is totally transformed. What was once bread and wine are now Christ's body and blood. A handy word was coined to describe this unique change. Transformation of the "sub-stance", what "stands-under" the surface, came to be called "transubstantiation."

The relics of St Anthony of Padua will visit St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh on Thursday 16th and Friday 17th June 2016.



The relics will be welcomed at the Cathedral at 4pm on the Thursday afternoon and a special Mass will be celebrated on that evening by Archbishop Eamon Martin at 7.30pm. In his writings, St Anthony often speaks of mercy, describing God as the "Father of Mercy". 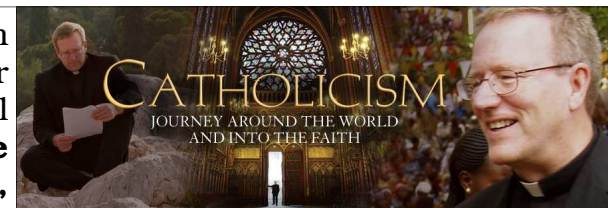
