


PARISH OF THE HOLY REDEEMER, DUNDALK **27TH MARCH 2016** EASTER SUNDAY

Easter Blessings in conjunction with the Parish Pastoral Council, Fr Paul, Fr Neil and all the team of Holy Redeemer Parish, wish all of our parishioners and their families and friends (particularly those who have come home for Easter) every blessing in this holy season.

Holy Communion - Our Easter Duty: Because of the central importance of Easter to the Christian faith, the Catholic Church requires that all Catholics who have made their First Communion receive the Holy Eucharist sometime during the Easter season, which lasts through to Pentecost 50 days after Easter. (The Church also urges us to take part in the Sacrament of Confession before receiving this Easter communion). This reception of the Eucharist is a visible sign of our faith and our participation in the Kingdom of God. Of course, although we should receive Holy Communion as frequently as possible; this "Easter Duty" is simply the minimum requirement set by the Church.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church: Tuesdays after 10.00am Mass until 4pm. Every 1st Friday of the month 10.30am-4.00pm. 1st Saturday of every month after 7.30pm Mass. All are welcome to spend time with the Lord.

Friday is First Friday of the Month: The sick and housebound will be attended during the week as arranged.

Divine Mercy Devotion on First Friday: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after 10.00am Mass until 4.00pm. Holy Hour and Chaplet 3.00pm - 4.00pm.

Holy Hour: Next Saturday is the 1st Saturday of the month. Holy Hour with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church after 7.30pm Mass.


